Lib Dem Adrian Collett (right) and Hampshire Police Authority have increased the number of Police and PCSOs on our streets for the fourth year running.



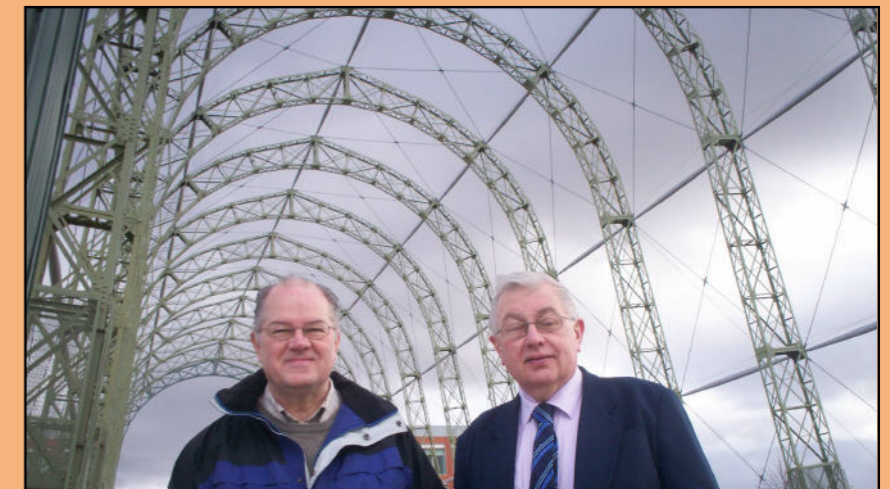
Preserving Conservation Areas
