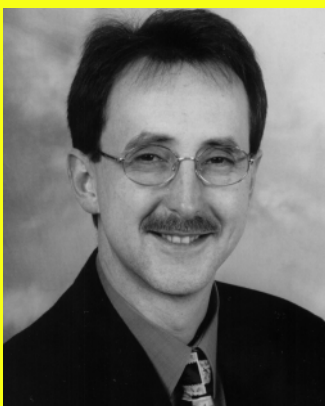

Philip Thompson is concerned at the impact of an increase in learner drivers on our roads.

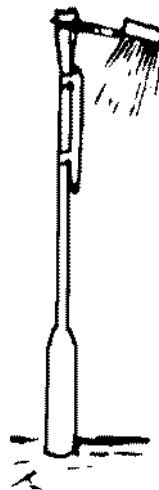
