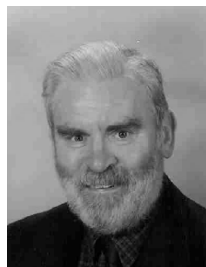
## The St Mark's FOCUS team

Rushmoor Council has published preferred strategies for development, environment, housing, transport and amenities for the next 30 years.

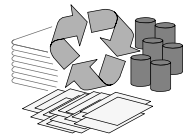
One plan proposes that "North Camp Village" should not be allowed to become a town centre like Farnborough or Aldershot. Do you agree?

## Recycling Problems

There are frequent problems with traffic queues approaching the recycling centre on the Eelmoor Industrial Estate. Liberal Democrats are lobbying Hampshire County Council to deal with this. In the meantime our advice is:
